



## **So Easy Cowl** Designed by Michele Stitches

This crocheted cowl is a very simple, straightforward “recipe” using linen stitch. You can adjust the number of stitches for any width, and the number of rows for any length you want.

Use whatever yarn you desire, and the hook size that gives you the fabric drape that you prefer. There are LOTS of tutorials on the internet for linen stitch if you need a little extra help.

The display model in Meadowlark Yarns was crocheted using Malabrigo Rastita in the colorway “Arco Iris” and a 4.5 mm crochet hook.

Here is how the model was made.

### **Set Up**

For the beginning, chain approx. 44-46 stitches.  
Then crochet the entire cowl in linen stitch.

### **Row 1**

Skip first two chains, single crochet in the next chain space.  
\*Ch 1, skip the next ch and sc in the next ch\*

Repeat this sequence between the asterisks to the end. Ch 2 and turn.

### **Subsequent Rows**

Sc in the first ch-1 space. Ch-1, sc in the next ch-1 space.  
Repeat instructions between asterisks until you get to the end.  
Ch 2 and turn.

When cowl is desired length, block flat, then seam the two ends together.
