Cozy Twisty Cowl Designed by Deb Coombs of Neota Designs

Level: Advanced Beginner

Materials:

Neota Designs Zephyr 100% Wool (fingering)
2 – 1 oz skeins (same or two different colors),
size 3 circular needles 16”– 20” (size 3 straights 12” optional)
I used one skein Boulder Raspberry (Color A) and one skein Golden Meadow (Color B).
One marker.

Ruffle:

With Color A cast on 240 stitches. (I find it easier with a fine yarn and small needles to cast on to straight needles *first* and transfer to DPNs a few rows later. You will have to sew the tail in anyways so you might as well make it easy and sew a gap and not worry about DPNs dangling in the wind and twisting.)

Row 1:: K6, P6

Row 2: P6, K6

Repeat rows 1 & 2 for a total of ten times.

Row 11: transfer to circ needles as you K2 tog around (120 st)

Make sure there are no twists in your work. This will be very evident since you knit the first ten rows on straights. Now add *one* twist, place marker, and join your knitting into a circular piece.

Cowl Body:

Row 1 & 2: Color A – P3, K3 , repeat across row

Row 3 & 4: Color B – P2, *K3, P3*, end K3, P1

Row 5 & 6: Color A – P1, *K3, P3*, end K3, P2

Row 7 & 8: Color B – K3, P3, repeat across row

Row 9 & 10: Color A – K2, *P3, K3*, end P3, K1

Row 11 & 12: Color B – K1, *P3, K 3*, end P3, K2

Repeat rows 1 -10

Ruffle:

With Color B, knit one row. Next row: K1, Increase 1 (240 st)

Rows 1-10: K6, P6

Finishing:

Bind off loosely

Use mattress stitch to close the seam at the beginning.
