



Hittin' the Open Road Beanie

Designed by Ivy Sipes

Materials:

1 skein of Cascade Heritage Black
1 ball Dyed by Darrell gradient or "vari--dient"
US 1 16" circular needle, US 2 16" circular needle
Set of US 2 Double pointed needles or size to obtain gauge.
Tapestry needle
Optional: stitch Markers

Size:

Preemie 12"
(Baby 14¼", Toddler 16½", Child 18", Women 21", Men 23½")

Gauge: 32 sts = 4" in pattern

Let's DO this!

With smaller needle cast on 96 (112, 132, 144, 168, 184)
Join in the round be careful not to twist.

Place marker

K2, P2 repeating to marker

Continue in established pattern for 1" (1.25", 1.5", 1.75", 2", 2")

Switch to bigger needles

Increase Row sizes Baby, and Men: *Knit - (56, -, -, 93), M1* Repeat twice.

96 (114, 132, 144, 168, 186 sts)



All Sizes:

Knit chart 1 Repeating 15 (18, 20, 23, 27, 29) times around and for 4" (5", 5.5", 7", 8", 9") From top of ribbing or desired length ending on round 14.

Knit Decrease Chart once

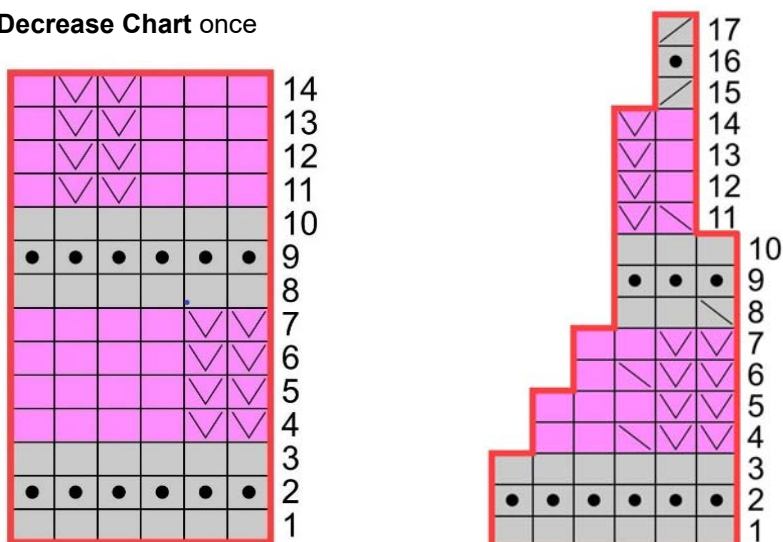

Stitches
 □ k
 ● p
 ▽ s1
 ▤ ssk

Borders
 — stitch repeat

Cut Yarn and draw through remaining stitches.
Weave in ends and brag!
