

The Cowgirl Convertible

Designed for Knit and Crochet by Maureen Johnson and Lori Kirk

KNIT it!

Yarn: US 8 16" circular needle,
1 skein of Mountain Meadow Wool Worsted Weight Tweed,
stitch marker

Set-up: Using the long tail cast on method, cast on 96
stitches onto the US8 16" circular needle. Place marker.
Join for working in the round.

Rib the Cuff: *K1, P1* repeat *-* till end of row. Repeat
this row till piece measures 1.5" from cast on edge

Body: Knit every row even till piece measures 9 inches
from cast on edge.

Eyelet Row: *K6, YO, K2tog* repeat *-* till end of row.

Top Edge: Knit 3 rows even. Then, for one row, *K1, P1* repeat *-* till end of row.

Bind off: Bind off in K1, P1 pattern. Fasten off final stitch.



CROCHET It!

Materials: US H crochet hook, 1 skein of Mountain Meadow Wool Worsted Weight Tweed, removable stitch marker

Set-up: Ch 70 sts. Sl st into the first ch st to join in the round. Place marker at beginning of round. Move marker as necessary to mark the beginning of the round throughout the project.

Round 1: Ch 3 (counts as first stitch), dc in each of the 69 remaining stitches around, sl st into top of ch to join.

Round 2-4: Ch 2 (counts as first stitch), *fpdc 1, sc 1* repeat *-* around, sl st into ch to join.

Round 5-20: Ch 3 (counts as first stitch), dc in each stitch around, sl st into ch to join

Round 21: Ch 3(counts as first stitch), dc in next 5 sts, ch 1, *dc in next 6 sts, ch 1* repeat *-* around, sl st into ch to join.

Round 22: Ch 3(counts as first stitch), dc in each of the 69 remaining sts around, sl st into top of ch to join.

Round 23: Ch 2 (counts as first stitch), *fpdc 1, sc 1* repeat *-* around, sl st into ch to join

Fasten Off final stitch.

Finishing for both Knit and Crochet Versions

Drawstring: Cut 6 pieces of yarn 40" long. Tie an overhand knot 2 inches from one end. Tape knot to table. Braid the six pieces (two pieces per one third bundle) and tie an overhand knot roughly 3 inches from the end. Trim ends on both sides so they are even

- Block piece lightly. Do not overstretch the bottom ribbing section.
- Weave in ends.
