

Augustine Cowl

This pattern is perfect for beginners, because it has a one row repeat! You can easily adapt it with any yarn and hook size, which means your gauge will change. For my cowl, it measured 5.5"x9.5" before blocking, and the gauge came out to 13 stitches and 11 rows = 4" before blocking. Happy crocheting!

Materials:

1 Skein of Malabrigo Rios (Worsted weight, 210 yds)

Notions:

1 M/N (9.0mm) crochet hook

Tapestry needle

Gauge:

Measured 5.5"x9.5" before blocking, and the gauge came out to 13 stitches and 11 rows = 4" before blocking.

Abbreviations & Definitions:

Ch - Chain (the foundation of your work)

Sc - Single Crochet

Sl St - Slip Stitch

Instructions:

Let's Begin!

Chain 60, being careful not to twist, join in the round with a slip stitch.

Set up round:

Single crochet around, joining back up with a slip stitch.

Round 1: Ch 1, sc in the front post to end of round, sl st to beginning ch.

Repeat Round 1 until cowl reaches 5.5"

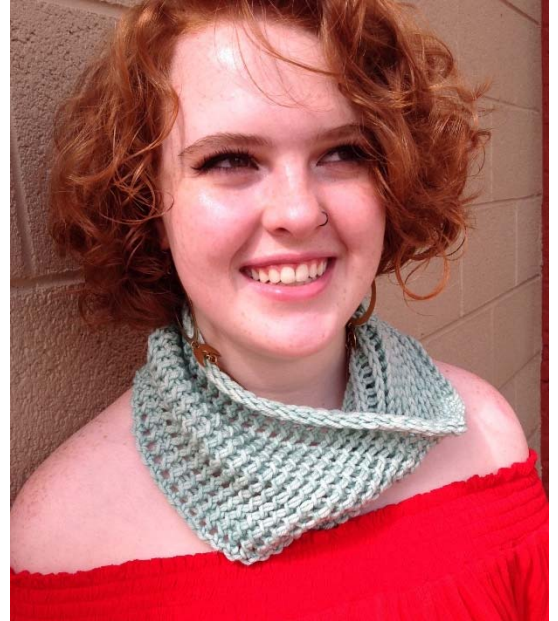
Weave in ends, and wet block.
