

Wither Shawl

A simple shawl that uses just 1 skein (300 yards) of bulky yarn from Hue Loco! 4 different textures are created using slipped stitches and twisted stitches.

Materials:

Yarn:

1 skein Hue Loco bulky weight yarn 300 yards per 250 gram (note these are large skeins) sample used
1 skein in “beach glass”

US#9 needles 24-32 inch circulars or straight needles

4 stitch markers

Darning needle for weaving in ends

Gauge:

13 stitches per 4 inches in stockinette

Stitch definitions:

K-knit

P-purl

YO- yarn over, bring the yarn forward between the needles and around the back of the right needle to create a hole in the knitting (1 stitch increased)

S1WYIF- slip one stitch purlwise with yarn in front

S1WYIB- slip one stitch purlwise with yarn in back

TBL- through the back loop (this creates a twisted stitch)

K2TOG- knit the next 2 stitches together

PM- place marker

SLM- slip marker

Notes:

- You may repeat the sections as many times as you like, it will not change any of the other sections.
- On all wrong side rows, slip all markers as you come to them.
- Each textured section ends with a right side row, except the twisted stitch section, this one ends on a wrong side row.
- The eyelet section begins with a wrong side row

Pattern:

Garter tab cast on:

Cast on 3 stitches, knit 6 rows, do not turn work, rotate work 90 degrees, pick up and knit 3 stitches along long side of work (1 stitch in each garter bump) rotate another 90 degrees pick up and knit 3 stitches along cast on edge. You now have 9 stitches on your needle.

Set up row 1: K3, PM, YO, K1, YO, PM, K1, PM, YO, K1, YO, PM, K3

Set up row 2: K3, P to last marker, K3

Stockinette Section:

Row 1 (RS): K3, SLM, YO, K to marker, YO, SLM, K1, SLM, YO, K to marker, YO, SLM, K3

Row 2 (WS): K3, P to last marker, K3

Repeat rows 1 and 2 - 8 times

Then work row 1 once (you will be able to count 10 YO's up the center of the shawl)

Eyelet Section:

Row 1 (WS): K all stitches

Row 2(RS): K3, SLM, YO, K1, [YO, K2TOG] repeat [-] to marker, YO, SLM, K1, SLM, [YO, K2TOG] repeat [-] to 1 stitch before marker, YO, K1, YO, SLM, K3

Row 3 (WS): K all stitches

Slipping Stitches Section:

Row 1 (RS): K3, SLM, YO, [K1, S1WYIB] repeat [-] to 1 stitch before marker, K1, YO, SLM, K1, SLM, YO, [K1, S1WYIB] repeat [-] to 1 stitch before marker, K1, YO, SLM, K3

Row 2 (WS): K3, P to last marker, K3

Repeat rows 1 & 2- 9 times total

Then work row 1 once

Repeat Eyelet Section:

Row 1 (WS): K all stitches

Row 2(RS): K3, SLM, YO, K1, [YO, K2TOG] repeat [-] to marker, YO, SLM, K1, SLM, [YO, K2TOG] repeat [-] to 1 stitch before marker, YO, K1, YO, SLM, K3

Row 3 (WS): K all stitches

Half Linen Stitch Section:

Row 1 (RS): K3, SLM, YO, [K1, S1WYIF] repeat [-] to 1 stitch before marker, K1, YO, SLM, K1, SLM, YO, [K1, S1WYIF] repeat [-] to 1 stitch before marker, K1, YO, SLM, K3

Row 2 (WS): K3, P to last marker, K3

Repeat rows 1 & 2- 9 times total

Then work row 1 once

Repeat Eyelet Section:

Row 1 (WS): K all stitches

Row 2(RS): K3, SLM, YO, K1, [YO, K2TOG] repeat [-] to marker, YO, SLM, K1, SLM, [YO, K2TOG] repeat [-] to 1 stitch before marker, YO, K1, YO, SLM, K3

Row 3 (WS): K all stitches

Twisted stitches Section:

Row 1 (RS): K3, SLM, YO, K TBL to marker, YO, SLM, K1, SLM, YO, K TBL to marker, YO, SLM, K3

Row 2 (WS): K3, P to last marker, K3

Repeat rows 1 and 2 - 9 times total

Garter Border:

Row 1 (RS): K3, SLM, YO, K to marker, YO, SLM, K1, SLM, YO, K to marker, YO, SLM, K3

Row 2 (WS): K All stitches

Repeat rows 1 and 2 - 2 times total (4 rows in garter stitch)

Bind off as follows on the right side:

Knit 1 stitch, knit the next stitch, slip both stitches back to left hand needle, knit 2 together through the back loops, (knit 1, pass both stitches back to left hand needle, knit 2 together through the back loops), rep () until 1 stitch remains, break yarn and pull through loop.

Weave in ends, and block!



Add tassels! (Optional)

Make 3:

Take a 3 inch square of cardboard wrap the yarn around it 20-25 times. Take another length of yarn (about 4-5 inches long) thread through the yarn wrapped around the cardboard and tie it tightly around the yarn. Take the yarn off the cardboard and cut though the yarn on the opposite side of where it is tied. With an additional length of yarn (about 4-5 inches long) wrap the tassel about ½ an inch below where it is tied.

Secure on to shawl at each point.
