



Concentric Cotton Biased Poncho

Designed by Ivy Sipes

Materials:

1 Ball of Concentric Cotton (100% Pima Cotton; 200 gms/ 929 yards)
US 6 32" Circular Needle, tapestry needle

Gauge:

23 over 4" in garter stitch

Finished Garment:

Let's Go:

Cast on 3 stitches

Row 1: K2, Kfb.

Row 2: Kfb, knit to end.

Row 3: Knit to last stitch, Kfb.

Row 4: Kfb, knit to end.

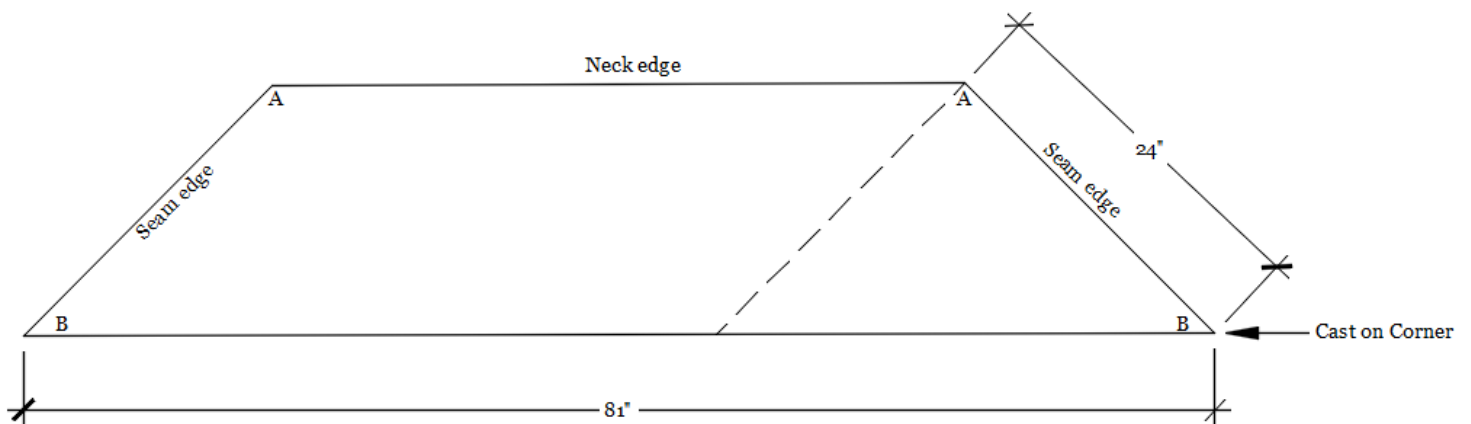
Repeat rows 3 and 4 until piece measures 24" from cast on.

Body row 1: K2tog, knit to last st, Kfb.

Body Row 2: Kfb, knit to last 2 sts, K2tog.

Repeat Body Rows 1 and 2 until piece measures 81" or desired length. (make sure to leave enough yarn to bind off and seam piece. About 9 times the width of piece about 10 yards) Bind off.

Seam shoulder seam- Refer to Schematic; matching A to A, and B to B.



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
