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BRIMMED CROCHETED HAT

Designed for Lambpun

Size: One size

Finished measurement: 21" circumference

Materials: Yarn: Approximately 340 yards of Sport to Worsted weight yarn for main color (MC).

Optional: Approximately 50 yards of contrast color (CC) for a band and edging.

Hook: Size G (or size necessary to obtain gauge)

Tapestry needle

Pin or stitch marker

Gauge: 3 ½ sts = 1" To save time, take time to check your gauge.

Abbreviations: Stitch (st), Chain (ch); single crochet (sc); half-double crochet (hdc); double crochet (dc) increase (inc), Reverse Single Crochet (Reverse SC), Round (Rnd), Single Crochet (SC), Slip Stitch (Sl St), Yarn Over (YO)

Instructions:

Crown:

Ch 3, join with Sl St to form ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 2 (counts as a HDC now and throughout the pattern), work 11 HDC in a ring, and join with Sl St to top of Ch 2. [12 HDC (Ch 2 plus 11 HDC)].

Hint: Place a pin in the top of the Ch 2 of each rnd to mark the beginning of the rnd. Keep moving the pin to the top of the Ch 2 of each rnd throughout.

Rnd 2: Ch 2, HDC in same st as Ch 2, work 2 HDC in each st around. Join with Sl St to top of Ch 2. [24 HDC (Ch 2 plus 23 HDC); 12 incs made].

Rnd 3: Ch 2, *1 HDC in each of next 2 Sts, 2 HDC in next St*. Repeat from * to * to the end of the rnd by working 1 HDC in each of last 2 Sts. Join with Sl St to top of Ch 2. [31 HDC total; 7 incs made.]

Rnd 4: Ch 2, *1 HDC in each of next 3 Sts, 2 HDC in next St*. Repeat from * to * to the end of the rnd by working 1 HDC in each of last 2 Sts. Join with Sl St to top of Ch 2. [38 HDC total; 7 incs made.]

For Rnds 5-9: Add or subtract rows in this area for that perfect, custom fit.

Rnd 5: Ch 2, *1 HDC in each of next 4 Sts, 2 HDC in next St*. Repeat from * to * to the end of the rnd, by working 1 HDC in each of last 2 Sts. Join with Sl St to top of Ch 2. [45 HDC total; 7 incs made.]

Rnd 6: Ch 2, *1 HDC in each of next 5 Sts, 2 HDC in next St*. Repeat from * to * to the end of the rnd, by working 1 HDC in each of last 2 Sts. Join with Sl St to top of Ch 2. [52 HDC total; 7 incs made.]



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Rnd 7: Ch 2, *1 HDC in each of next 6 Sts, 2 HDC in next St*. Repeat from * to * to the end of the rnd, by working 1 HDC in each of last 2 Sts. Join with Sl St to top of Ch 2. [59 HDC total; 7 incs made.]

Rnd 8: Ch 2, *1 HDC in each of next 7 Sts, 2 HDC in next St*. Repeat from * to * to the end of the rnd, by working 1 HDC in each of last 2 Sts. Join with Sl St to top of Ch 2. 66 HDC total; 7 incs made.

Rnd 9: Ch 2, *1 HDC in each of next 8 Sts, 2 HDC in next St*. Repeat from * to * to the end of the rnd, by working 1 HDC in each of last 2 Sts. Join with Sl St to top of Ch 2. 73 HDC total; 7 incs made.

Depth of Crown:

Rnds 10-18 (or desired depth of crown): Ch 2 at the beginning of each rnd, work 1 HDC in next St and each St around. Join with Sl St to top of Ch 2. [73 HDC total]. *Notes:* 1. No incs are worked in these rnds. 2. If you want a deeper crown, work more rnds.

Brim:

Hint: When changing colors, work the last St of the previous rnd such that the last YO of the St is worked by picking up the new CC. Finish the round by joining with a Sl St to top of Ch 2 with the CC.

Rnd 19: With contrast yarn, Ch 2, and work 1 HDC in each St around. [73 HDC total.]

Rnd 20: Ch 1, SC around. Join with Sl St to Ch 1.

Rnd 21: With MC, Ch 2 *1 HDC in each of next 2 Sts, 2 HDC in next St (1 Inc made)*. Repeat from * to * to the end of the rnd by working 1 HDC in each of last 2 Sts. Join with Sl St to top of Ch 2.

Rnds 22-24: Ch 2, work 1 HDC in each St around. Join with Sl St to top of Ch 2.

Edging:

Hint: After joining CC, Ch 1 and turn so that the remaining single crochet rnd will be on the correct side when the brim is turned up. If you will not be turning the brim of the hat up when wearing, Ch 1 after joining the CC, but do not turn.

Optional Hint: Do not cut MC. Carry the MC along the top of each St such that as you work the SCs, the MC is woven in. This will give the edging more body.

Join CC, Ch 1 and turn, SC in same St as Ch 1, SC in each St around; join with Sl St to top of Ch 1.

Optional Edging: Ch 1, work reverse SC (SC backwards) around and join with Sl St to Ch 1.

Finish off.



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
