The Ultimate Hat by Sun May copywrite strikkefrenzy

This pattern is very simple and a quick knit, as I wanted a warm, comfy and slouchy hat asap. I wrote it down since it is really not that much to write at all 😊. The cables are the easiest there is, and doesn't look too bad, do they? I hope you like the pattern, enjoy!

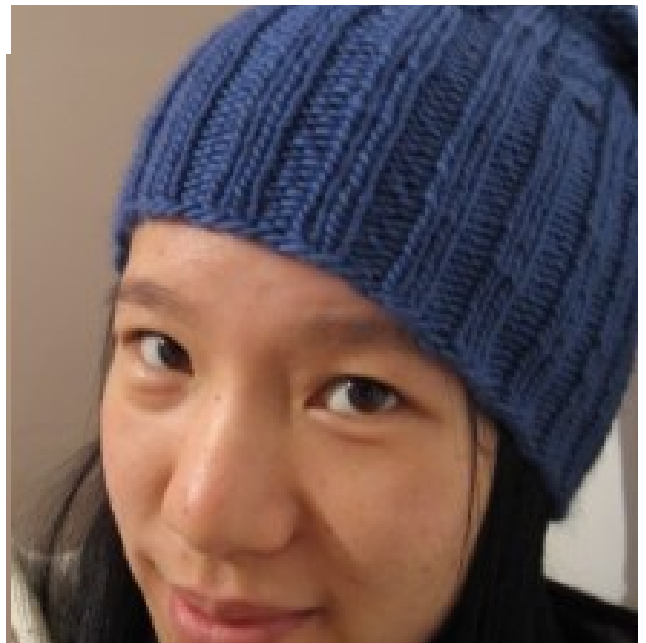
Materials needed:

4.5 mm and 5.5mm DPN's or circular needles
100g Malabrigo Worsted or Abuelita Worsted
(200m/218yrd/100g)

Tapestry needle to weave in ends
Cable needle if you use it (I do the cables without, which is really simple, try yourself!)

Abbreviations:

CO – cast on
sts - stiches
k – knit
p – purl
k2tog – knit 2 together
2x2 Rib – k2, p2
CABLE – put 2 sts on cable needle and hold in front, knit 2, knit the 2 sts on the cable needle.



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Gauge:

20 sts per 10 cm/4 inches in 2x2 Rib (4.5 mm needles)

(row gauge not important, and to be honest, I very seldom check gauge so this is a sorta warning)

If you get the wrong gauge, you can increase/decrease the number of sts by multiples of 8. (I'm contradictory, no?)

Directions:

- CO 88 sts using 4.5 mm needles and join to knit on the round in 2x2 Rib.
- Knit 2x2 ribbing for 12 cm/5 inches.
- Change to 5.5 mm and do one round (k2, p1, k4, p1), repeat to the end of round.
- **A:** Do a cable twist round as follows: (k2, p1, CABLE, p1), repeat to end.
- **B:** Work 4 rounds (k2, p1, k4, p1) repeat.
- Repeat A and B until work measures 27 cm/11 inches, end with round A. (try on the hat and see how long you want it!)
- Decrease by doing the following:
 - Round 1: (k2, p1, k2tog, k2tog, p1) repeat. You have 66 sts left.
 - Round 2: (k2tog, p1, k2tog, p1) repeat. 44 sts left.
 - Round 3: k2tog all sts. 22 sts left.

Cut yarn, pull the thread *twice* through the sts, weave in ends. Done! 😊



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
